Kati's hand-thrown vessels are simple and classical in shape. The unglazed surfaces with their silky sheen and sensous feel invite to touch and to hold.

This is created by repeated burnishing (rubbing) with polished stones of the surface. In the

final firing the pots are exposed to dense smoke. The smoke is applied in a variety of ways to create spontaneous irregular patterns, contrasting random patches or deliberately "drawn" carbon lines. Kati can never be in complete control. She can only direct and influence the natural process of carbonisation. Each finished piece is a surprise and unique.

Kati will be at **45 Southside** on the 27th of March 2011 from 2:30 pm. She will be holding a demonstration of her techniques at 3:30 pm. All are welcome.
